### **AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION**

- Taxis are available at the Airport Cab Stand, or outside the Powell Street entrance. Approximate charge, one-way: \$50-55 excluding gratuity, for up to four people. Allow 30-45 minutes total travel time.
- Rental Cars are available throughout San Francisco International, as well as around Union Square. There is a Hertz Rental Car Desk in the hotel's Landmark Building Lobby.
- MUNI – Public transportation at \$2.00 per person and \$ 0.75 for children and Seniors. Operating hours vary by line.
- Cable Car – operating hours are 6am to 12 midnight. \$7 per person.
- BART – from Powell Street to Oakland Airport \$10.05 each way or \$20.10 roundtrip; from Powell Street to SFO \$8.95 each way or \$17.90 round trip.
- Shuttle Service - Service on Geary Street - All services are by reservation only. Rate: \$17.00 (to SFO)

They say that history repeats itself and there is no better evidence than in this beautiful, ever-changing dining room which is a testimonial to the historic Westin St. Francis Hotel, our loyal guests and patrons and to the great City of San Francisco. The Oak Room Restaurant serves a full menu of American favorites with international flavors for breakfast and lunch. Menus include Westin Kids Club™ Program items for children under 12, and "Super Food" selections that are higher in protein and lower in sodium and fat. Breakfast every day from 6:30 a.m. - 11:30 am; Lunch 12 noon – 2:00 p.m. Buffet features Eggs Benedict/ Dim Sum. Breakfast table will also feature a two egg omelet. Located in the Landmark Building; Cocktails, appetizers, WIFI access.

### **CLOCK BAR**

The quintessential San Francisco meeting place, CLOCK BAR is the only San Francisco cocktail lounge created by Michelin Star Chef Michael Mina. CLOCK BAR's cocktail program focuses on fresh produce and premium spirits. Inspired by the classics and motivated by the seasons, the cocktails rotate to highlight ingredients at the peak of freshness. CLOCK BAR's Tipple List showcases the best cocktail creations from both past and present bartenders. Cocktails and Daily Punches from \$10, Beers starting at \$8. Located in the Landmark Building.

Located in the Tower Lobby, Caruso's offers specialty coffee drinks, homemade pastries, wines by the glass, Panini sandwiches, salads and a full bar. Bar menu available 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. and cocktail service from 1p.m. to 8:00pm. Wireless access.

### **CHATEAU MONTELENA WINERY – TASTING ROOM**

The Tasting Room is open to the public Sunday-Saturday from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The Tasting Room is located, just off the Landmark Lobby across from the Grand Staircase. Chateau Montelena wines are available to taste and for purchase, along with other memorabilia from the Chateau.

Established in 1882, Calistoga-based Chateau Montelena is credited for helping California wine earn worldwide recognition. In 1976, Chateau Montelena was one of two Napa Valley wineries to come out on top in a blind tasting held for a who's-who of the French wine and food establishment gathered at the Inter-Continental Hotel in Paris. Chateau Montelena produces Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Zinfandel and Riesling varieties. The winery has been owned and operated by the Barrett Family since 1972.
